A student who qualifies according to the following criteria and continues an education at an A+ approved Missouri public community college or vocational-technical school may be eligible for state reimbursed tuition and general fees for up to two years within 4 years after graduation, **contingent upon state appropriation and allocation of funding, and St. Pius X High School maintaining designation.** Each student should enter into a written agreement with the school prior to the end of 1st semester their senior year. To be eligible, the student must:

- Attended a designated A+ School for three consecutive years prior to high school graduation.
- Graduated from high school with a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 (a 2.499 GPA is not eligible).
- Maintained at least a 95% cumulative attendance record for all four years of high school. (Note: this is more stringent than the attendance rate for the rest of the student body).
- Perform a total of 50 hours of unpaid tutoring/mentoring of other students under the supervision of an Archdiocese School employee.
- Made a documented, good faith effort to secure available federal post-secondary student financial assistance funds that do not require payment (FAFSA application must be completed and mailed to the school that the student is planning to attend).
- Maintained a record of good citizenship as outlined on page 5 of the student handbook. Note the disqualifications and appeal process if one qualifies.
- Male students must register with the Selective Services within 30 days of 18th birthday.
- Achieve proficient or advanced on the EOC Algebra I; or achieve a qualifying score on the alternate math test that is established annually by the MDHE/CBHE.
- U.S. Citizen or permanent resident in order to receive reimbursement under the A+ Scholarship Program.

The student's financial incentive is contingent upon state appropriation and allocation of funding. Dependent on said, funding may be available for up to four years after high school graduation. To maintain eligibility during that time, each participating student must enroll and attend a Missouri public community college or vocational school on a full-time basis and maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher.
