

SLU Jesuit Community Scholarship Application

To support the continued education of students from Catholic high schools in the metropolitan area, Saint Louis University offers the SLU Jesuit Community Scholarship. This award is funded through the Jerome J. Marchetti, S.J. Endowment Fund.

The value of the award will be equally divided between fall and spring terms. Scholarships will range in value from \$5,000 to full tuition, based on the financial need of each recipient.

APPLICATION CRITERIA:

- ❖ Student must have a cumulative GPA of 3.2 or higher.
- ❖ Student must submit a 500-word essay on the topic, "What does a Catholic education mean to you?" (Attach to this application).
- ❖ Student must submit the essay and complete application to their high school counselor by the deadline established by the high school.
- ❖ Student must demonstrate financial need and submit the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) by **January 15th, 2019.**

RENEWAL CONDITIONS

- * Recipient must maintain full time attendance at Saint Louis University.
- * Recipient must maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- ❖ Recipient must perform 20 hours of service work at his/her alma mater annually while enrolled at SLU.
