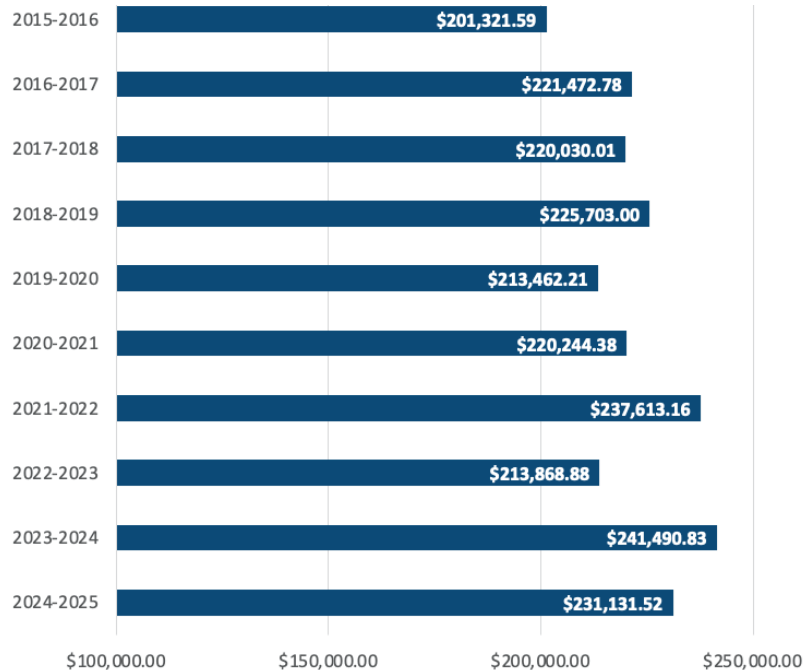

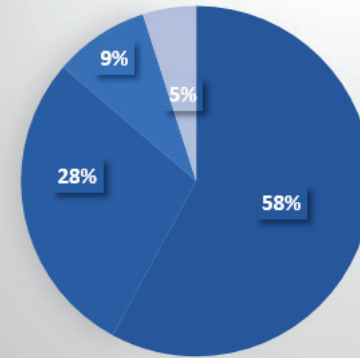

2024-2025 Revenue

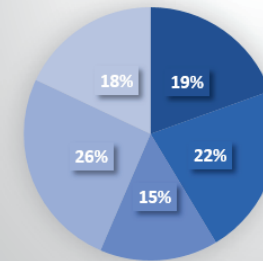

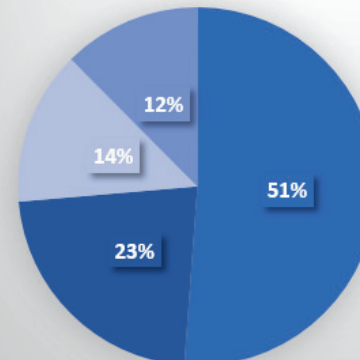
2024-2025 Contributions/Grants

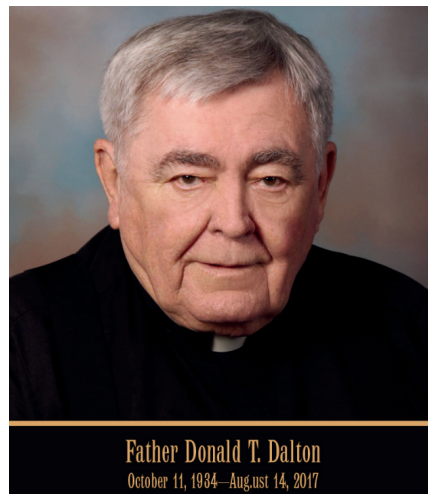
