

Service Hour Requirements

At St. Pius X High School, we believe that service is an integral part in living out the Catholic Faith. In order to foster service in the hearts of our students, St. Pius X encourages service hours within the family. The way that we act within our family is the foundation for our character and treatment of others around us. As St. Teresa of Calcutta said, " It is easy to love the people far away. It is not always easy to love those close to us. Bring love into your home, for this is where our love for each other must start." We believe that the family is not only the foundation of society and faith, but also service which is why we allow service hours done inside the home for all four years at St. Pius X.

Service done inside the home should <u>*not*</u> include chores that are already required of the student or for the functioning of the household. Appropriate service hours for family could be painting a room, yard work, etc.

The service and atmosphere inside of the home should propel students to care for those in their local communities. To help foster this, Pius X asks each student to serve at their parish or Pius X as well as service that helps those in need*. All students are asked to serve in a program or project that helps **people** who are disadvantaged.

There are many ways to serve the needs of others. St. Pius X students are asked to work with any of these seven groups^{*}, **unless they have received direct approval from the Campus Minister.** Your service should be split up into **at least 3 of these categories each year**.

People in need:

- 1. Poor, Hungry, Homeless
- 2. Sick, Injured
- 3. Physically Challenged
- 4. Elderly
- 5. Academically Challenged
- 6. St. Pius X and/or your parish/church
- 7. Family & Friends

All hours need to be logged with a photo and supervisor email to be approved in MobileServe

Work that is required by a sport or club cannot be counted as service hours. Ex. As an Ambassador you are required to work open house. Team managers are only to count hours if they go beyond basic managing tasks.

12 hours required during <u>Freshmen Year</u> Split between at least three of the above categories 4 hours will be earned during a service day field trip

20 hours required during <u>Sophomore Year</u> Split between at least three of the above categories

34 hours required during <u>Junior Year</u> Split between at least three of the above categories

34 hours required during <u>Senior Year</u> Split between at least three of the above categories due by April 15 of their Senior Year

Notes: This will accumulate to a Minimum of 100 Total Service Hours Hours are to be entered into MobileServe 10 days after the date of service. *You may use the same categories each year.
